St. John's University again refuses to approve Turning Point USA

Bill in the News (The College Fix): The university "has been trending secular" though it "once [was] a bastion of traditional moral values," Bill Donohue said. He is the president of the Catholic League for Religious and Civil Rights. His group "defends the right of Catholics – lay and clergy alike – to participate in American public life without defamation or discrimination."
