DONOHUE NAILS NARAL

On October 29, William Donohue appeared on "News Forum," a Sunday morning talk show on the NBC New York affiliate. Hosted by veteran reporter Gabe Pressman, Donohue debated Kelli Conlin of the National Abortion Rights Action League (NARAL) on the subject of abortion and politics.
