GLAAD ISN'T HAPPY

After Bill Donohue appeared on the "Today" show on October 13, the Gay & Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation (GLAAD) went bonkers. Its president, Neil G. Giuliano called Donohue's comments about the role of homosexuals in the sexual abuse scandal "baseless, defamatory [and] calculated to fuel antigay sentiment." He provided no evidence to support his baseless charge.

During the interview, Donohue cited the John Jay Report that was commissioned by the bishops on this subject.
