IRS ASKED TO REVOKE STATUS OF HATE GROUP

Catholic League president William Donohue announced today that he is asking the Internal Revenue Service to revoke the taxexempt status of Frances Kissling's Catholics for a Free Choice:

"The IRS provides a tax-exempt status to organizations that serve the public interest. It is the contention of the Catholic League that Catholics for a Free Choice is an anti-Catholic hate group, and therefore forfeits its status as a public charity; hence, it should be denied a tax exemption. We will supply the IRS with the necessary background information."
