

LEAGUE FINDS NO HUMOR IN "THAT'S FUNNY" CALENDAR

This contribution, authored by someone called Elayne Boosler, is disparaging and deserves a response. In a letter to the president of the company, Michael Cader, we asked him to explain why his company listed this entry.
