

NY Times: “Religion” Guided Terrorists

On the front page of today’s paper, the [New York Times offered the headline](#) “In Large Immigrant Family, Religion Guided 3 Held in Fort Dix Plot” for an article about the men arrested for plotting a terror attack against soldiers in New Jersey.
