OXFORD UNION SET FOR STAGED DEBATE

Catholic League president Bill Donohue comments on tomorrow's debate at the Oxford Union:

At the beginning of December, I was <u>invited</u> to participate in a debate at the Oxford Union on the alleged sins of the Catholic Church. I agreed. A month later, I was disinvited. Those who extended the invitation then lied about it.
